# **Approval of Minutes**

Sanya Payne motioned to approve minutes, Amy Jessen seconded the motion. Minutes were approved.

## **Other Reports**

- Rules of Order: reviewed handout regarding requirements for SCC to adopt rules and order of procedure. Meetings are open to the public and meeting info can be found on school website.
- Temperature for Inside Day: discussed options for a minimum temperature for going outside. Decided that 20 degrees is a good minimum unless there is strong wind or precipitation. If the temperature is above that but still cold, it is at the teacher's discretion whether the class will take a full recess. Children spotted without coats will be reminded and calls home may be made.
- SNAP Plan: Safe walking routes /maps were also reviewed.
- Website: Many improvements have been made. Positive feedback was given.
- Report Netsmart: There will be an assembly Mid-January.
- Skylert Notes: Trying to streamline information so printed flyers are not sent home more than once a month. There is some concern over families who may not have internet access, but the preferred method of communication is Skylert/PeachJar.

- Drop-off/Pick-up: Reviewed Map. Looks very good. Color Coding is very helpful. Drop off/pick up has gone smoothly. Teacher helpers are doing a great job. Map will be posted to website.
- Safety Information: Doors are currently locked from 8:45-2:50 with side doors open during respective lunch times. Sanya Payne voiced concern over straggling kindergarteners being locked out of the building in the cold. Others agreed. It was determined that the first grade would assign "leaders" to stand inside the doors until 8:45 to make sure the stragglers get in OK. They will be instructed to not let adults in. Adults will need to use the front doors. Drills: Shelter in place, Lock-down and Earthquake. Teachers must wear badges at all times. Visitors and volunteers must check in and print a temp badge. Front-end staff is new and is requiring ID for parents to check out students.
- Halloween Feedback: Halloween parade was a success. All in attendance agreed it went very well.
  Some students and parents were upset about the "no masks" rule. It should not be an issue next year now that everyone knows what to expect.
