**Approval of November minutes:**

**Movie in the Park:**

We decided the food trucks will be too much and are going to look into getting a copyright release for the movie. We will revisit this idea next year.

Mrs. Tingey also proposed that we set up a grant specific to every grade. The grants will have a link that parents can donate to the grant/teacher. We are proposing we do this instead of no frills fundraising. We will need to send flyers home and sky alerts to help parents understand how it works and how to donate. This will give our teachers and school the much-needed supplies and the grants are matched up to a certain dollar amount through Jordan Education Foundation. Mrs. Tingey is working with the teachers to write their grants.

**School Improvement plan:**

Goal is to improve Tier 1 instruction and implement "I can" statements. People responsible for this action are Mrs. Tingey and Grade level Teams.

**Land Trust 2016-17:**

Aide Wish list: Three Literacy aides working with 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3rd grades and giving all teachers 1hr. and 45 minutes per week of aide time. 2 Computer aides five days a week. \$73,000 for all the aides needed. The money will come from the Land Trust budget and other school budgets. Having these aides will free up time for the teachers to have PLC's during the day each week, and Fridays can be used to plan for student and class needs.

The school is also in need of a P.E. Specialist. We discussed talking with the P.T.A. to see if they would be willing to donate enough money to hire one. Mrs. Tingey will ask H.R. if the P.T.A. can pay for an aide for more than 17 hrs. We would need the aide to be here for 20 hours a week. The cost should be \$10,000 a year for this aide position.

**Chick-fil-a Spirit Night:**

Mrs. Tingey proposed that we host a Spirit Night through Chick-fil-a. The teachers who choose to participate get a portion of the profits from that night to help with supplies for their classroom. Families are encouraged to go to Chick-fil-A on our spirit night to support the event. Mrs. Tingey and any teachers who are interested would donate their time to help pass out candy and stickers at the Chick-fil-a location. We would like to have our raccoon mascot there as well. We were all in favor of this idea. A date is not set yet.
