## Summary of compliance with Digital Citizenship

- NetSmartz De-Funded

## Riverton Elementary

- 2019-20 enrollment
  - Enrollment is down by 100 students compared to last year
- Focus –
  - Literacy- Lexia reading program (K-5), Heggerty phonemic awareness program (K-2), 95 percent group program (K-1), Multi Syllables program possibly starting in January (3-5 grades)
  - Math- Illustrative math program (6<sup>th</sup> grade)
  - Blended Digital Learning- 1:1 technology in grades 1-6 and 2:1 in Kindergarten
  - Kindness

## Safe Walking Routes

- Additions to route by city and/or district
  - The dismissal traffic is cleared within 8 minutes after the dismissal bell
  - Last year's proposed suggestions for the city - Sidewalks on the south side of 13150 (Construction is on), extended time on the crosswalk on 13200 S and Redwood
  - Last year's proposed suggestions for the district- Curb painting (completed), signs (replaced)
  - Additional suggestions for the city- Flashing stop signs, Safe walk route near 1830 W, 13070 S and 13035 S
  - Additional suggestions for the district- Move the recycle bin to a different spot, Curb painting prior to the school year beginning and sign replacements as needed.
