Principal's Message

April 1, 2022

Dear Parents,

We are actively engaged in preparations for another great year (2022-23) at Riverton Elementary.

Each school year, the Riverton Elementary School Community Council (SCC) approves the expenditure of LAND trust funds for the following year. Our focus is to support growth in literacy (K-6), Language Arts, Math, and Science. We will continue this focus next year. On March 23, 2022, the 2022-23 LAND trust plan was approved by the SCC.

This plan includes the expenditure of \$81,677.00 of funding for next year and an estimated carry over of \$15,000.00 from the current school year—totalling \$96,677.00.

These expenditures support two goals:

<u>Goal 1</u>: Increase the percentage of students making typical or better progress in reading by 5% from the end of year 2021-22 to end of year 2022-23 as measured by Acadience.

<u>Goal 2</u>: Increase the percentage of students performing at or above proficiency by 3% in Language Arts, Math, and Science as measured by RISE in grades 4-6 and Acadience in grades K-3.

The funding will be spent in the following areas:

Salaries & Benefits \$48,536.68 Substitutes \$5,678.21 Registration/Inservice \$10,000.00 Technology & Hardware \$32,858.47
