

Principal's Message

Dear Parents,

I hope you and your families had a wonderful Spring Break. It was fun to watch students (and teachers) return to school smiling through their masks and excited to be in school again.

Our School Community Council met before Spring Break to approve the school LANDtrust plan for next school year. Part of this plan included earmarking \$78,442.00 of LANDtrust funding to achieve Literacy and Social Emotional Learning goals at Riverton Elementary.

Our literacy goal for next school year is to:

- Increase the percentage of students making typical or better growth by 5% school wide from beginning of year to end of year as measured by Acadience (DIBELS) when compared to the previous year.

The majority of our funding will support aides and licensed teachers in implementing highly effective reading programs and processes.

Additionally, we will continue to implement social and emotional learning skills in the following areas:

- Self Awareness
- Social Awareness
- Decision Making
- Self Management Skills
- Relationship Skills.

We will gather Social Emotional Learning baseline information through the implementation of Panorama focusing on the number of students impacted and their response to academic and behavioral interventions and training staff in the use of the SEL room in the school.
