Minutes from SCC – Oct. 15, 2020

<u>Attendance</u>: Joel Pullan, Brenda Anderson, Cyndi Nordfelt, Kayci Richins, Annie Cannon, Amber Stroman, and Marcia Newbold

<u>Covid Update</u>: Riverton Elem. Has had 2 cases of covid ... students have been quarantined though due to sibling/family member/student.

**Ratify** – all in favor

<u>Membership</u> – need more parents. Sarah Erickson and Annie Cannon would like to not be on this committee this year.

#### Trustlands -

Joel went over budget that was left from 2020 - Most of the \$ goes to employees (aides). \$ was spent on Technology (chrome books) and textbooks. \$21,560.24 was leftover due to school dismissal.

Beginning year balance \$81,815.15 – Aides will be paid out of another budget that can't "roll over" from year to year. This budget will be used first before using this one to pay the aides. The school did buy est. \$41,000 for chrome books in K/1 and carts for those classrooms.

#### Safe Routes -

- 1. There is a grant available to help the city to get sidewalks down on 1300 West. Cyndi talked to Mayor Stagg about it and they are helping with the situation. (Joel got a message from city right before meeting ... he will call back and find out latest info.) Cyndi has documentation and pictures of the dangers there.
- 2. Still concerned about 4-way stop that has neighborhood north of the school concerned. City/police aren't as concerned. Neighbors are worried, esp. about kids that have to cross the road to the west. Committee wondered if that might be a parent concern to be there or neighbors to help.
