With the sudden increases in COVID-19 cases throughout Utah and the recent Salt Lake County mask mandate, I would like to take this opportunity to share the ongoing COVID-19 mitigation strategies we have been implementing this school year at Riverton Elementary.

Last year we increased cleaning and disinfecting protocols and increased air exchange throughout the school. This continues this year. The same hand sanitizing procedures for students and teachers continue—Students use hand sanitizer or wash hands when leaving an area and arriving in a new area.
