LANDtrust – 10% can roll over. We are now taking the aides from this account. Refer to the outline that was given. Expectations for kids and teachers ... working on the plan. "Wellness" aide – as part of this.

Rolling over \$35,000 over to next year. Counselor, aide, half time teacher for ESL. 2020-21 – 46.8 % to 51.73%. 2021-22 – not available but end of year was 63.7%.

This year, 78.81% of 6th graders are doing better! Credit to "walk to read" program. Lexia – when we compare last year to this year, we have far more kids performing better. It's good to see progress!

Goal 2 – it was not approved from the State ... so it was deleted. We didn't use any fund for this.

2022-23 year -

Goal – 1 (6 items) (see the handout!)

Raise it 5% for all kids ... We'll do:

Hire 4 aides for W to R, 2 rotation aides to support PLC, ongoing activities/prof. dev. for teachers.

Goal -2 (see handout)

RISE – 4-6th grade ... provide STEM opportunities, replace chrome books (this is a big one for us – need to replace 500!), build STEM library. We have authorization to run them one more year so we can spread out the cost. (\$280/chrome book – use for 6-7 years)

Budget Proposal ... See handout for the breakdown.

Voting on proposed budget ... ALL in favor.

After, we talked about a few changes for next year ... New Kindergarten teacher - hired Need still a 6th grade Alps teacher 5/6 teacher – hired 5th grade Alps teacher, Mrs. Thomson, moving to 4th Alps 4th grade Alps teacher, Mrs. Kilcrease moving to reg. ed. 4th

STEM learning lab ... in place of the computer lab because those computers are old. Instead of spending \$ on replacing them, it will become a STEM lab.
